This is the symbol called the "schwa", pronounced "sh..wa" as one syllable.

It is often used as a phonetic symbol.








The schwa sound

As a phonetic symbol, [ə] is a vowel articulated with the tongue body in a neutral position.



The tongue body is neither retracted, nor fronted, nor raised, nor lowered.
